## **Emergency Medical Technician Completion Course**

## Spring 2023

This is **PART TWO** of the EMT Certification course (see EMR flyer for details on part 1 of this course). This 112 hour course will prepare the **CURRENT Emergency Medical Responder** student to become an Emergency Medical Technician. Students who successfully complete this course will be eligible to sit for the National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) practical and written exams. The curriculum is based on the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration National EMS Education Standards for the Emergency Medical Technician (2009). The program follows a rigorous course of study that includes lecture, practical skills, and field internship. College credits are not offered, but participants are encouraged to check with their educational institution for possible credit allowances.

Attendance at all classes is required, 3 or more absences will likely result I course failure.

**Course Location:** Most classes will be held at the Northfield EMS Station, 1600 Riverview Lane, Northfield, MN, 55057. Three classes are held offsite (all within the City of Northfield) for scenario learning purposes.

**Cost:** The cost is \$1,150 (discounts available for affiliated agencies and hospital employees and their family members). **All fees must be paid in full by the first night of class – February 13<sup>th</sup>, 2023.** Cost includes tuition, textbook, handouts, electronic testing program fees and skills exam fees. Agencies can be invoiced. **PLEASE NOTE:** There is an additional \$9.10 fee for MDHS Background Study, \$80 NREMT Cognitive Exam fee, and individual immunization fees per your healthcare provider.

**Registration is required.** No walk-ins will be allowed. Course size is limited, and registrations are handled on a first-come, first-served basis. A waiting list will be established if needed.

### Prerequisites (please read carefully):

- All students must provide proof of standard healthcare provider immunizations, including, COVID-19 and annual Influenza vaccination, to attend NH+C Education Classes that include clinical rotations.
- Students must be a Minnesota Registered EMR; OR have successfully completed the NHCEMS EMR Initial course (see EMR Flyer).
- Our program requires the student to be 16 years of age prior to the last day of class. The NREMT exam must be taken within two years after the last day of class.
